Adult Division: Individual adult, age 17 years & up Child Division: Individual child, age 8-16 years Family Division: Group of 3-7 individuals of any age (1 adult/1 child minimum)



Adult Division Prizes

1st Place Adult Division - \$100 2nd Place Adult Division - \$75 3rd Place Adult Division - \$50

Child & Family Division Prizes

1st Place Child Division - \$75 2nd Place Child Division - \$50 3rd Place Child Division - \$25



- Ribbons will be awarded for 1st place, 2nd place & 3rd place in all three divisions.
- All entries are eligible for The Viewer's Choice Awards which will be awarded to one adult entry, one child entry & one family entry. Winners are selected by viewer voting and each winning entry will receive a \$275 check.

Rules for 2019

- 1) Any structure real or imaginary is eligible for entry.
- 2) Entry must be original no gingerbread kits allowed.
- 3) Entry must have **MAJOR** components, such as roof & walls, made of gingerbread (no graham crackers, cookies, etc).
- 4) All components must be edible. For example, all foil or plastic wrapped candies must be unwrapped; lollipops cannot have paper or plastic stems. **NO** perishable items can be used in the making of the entry.
- 5) You may add electric lighting to your entry.
- 6) Entry must have been constructed in 2019.
- 7) All entries will be judged on: Originality/Creativity, Overall Appearance, Use of Materials, Difficulty of Design, and Precision.
- 8) The main structure must be the dominant feature of the entry. The main structure can be NO smaller than 7" high by 8" wide.
- 9) Entries must be freestanding and attached to a plywood base that is **NO bigger than 18 inches wide x 24 inches long.** Entries cannot exceed 26" in height. The plywood base must be completely concealed with an edible product; however, the sides of the base do not have to be concealed. We suggest attaching a pretty ribbon around the sides of the base.
- 10) For prize money to be awarded in the Viewer's Choice Competition a division must have a minimum of five entries.
- 11) The Museum reserves the right not to display an entry, if the entry is not considered of show quality.
- 12) All entries must be delivered to the Museum in completed form on Sunday, November 24, 2019 between the hours of 12 noon 3 pm.
- 13) Entries must be picked up on Sunday, December 15, 2019 at 5 pm (no earlier) to be eligible for all awards and ribbons.

Registration

Participants must register for the competition by the deadline of <u>Friday, November 8, 2019</u>. Entry forms may be obtained by calling Darnall's Chance House Museum or visiting history.pgparks.com, clicking on Darnall's Chance House Museum, and then clicking on Gingerbread House Contest & Show.

Fee

A registration fee of \$5.00 is due for each entry. Cash, credit card, or check accepted. Checks must be made payable to **M-NCPPC**.
