I. PURPOSE

This directive establishes guidelines for the notification of military authorities by officers of this Division when they encounter United States military personnel in an offender status and to assure that all necessary data required for Division reports is provided.

II. INFORMATION NEEDED FOR NOTIFICATION/INCIDENT REPORTS

Members of this Division will ensure that they receive the following information for notification and incident report purposes:

- Name
- Rank
- Social Security Number
- Branch of Service
- Unit Assignment to include address
- Unit Commander or First Sergeant's Name

III. PROCEDURES FOR NOTIFICATION

When military personnel are arrested the arresting officer will contact the appropriate Military Agency to notify of the arrest. The appropriate armed forces law enforcement agency will be notified of the arrestee's name, rank and social security number.
