*Your account and associated fee rates will automatically default to "non-resident" status. If you are a resident of Prince George's or Montgomery County, you will need to visit a staffed M-NCPPC facility and show proof of age and residency to have your account updated to "resident" status. You will also need to provide valid proof of age for each immediate family member you add to your account before they can register for programs.
