

These Two Eagles Love Bladensburg Waterfront Park



Could it be? Have the bald eagles decided to build a new nest across from Bladensburg Waterfront Park? One of them was spotted, seemingly building a nest. The pair currently lives at the National Arboretum.

Majestic and iconic with striking white heads and tails, bald eagles are a sight to see at Bladensburg Waterfront Park. In the wild, bald eagles typically build their massive nests in tall trees near water, where they have easy access to fish, their primary food source. The males and females work together to construct these nests, which can weigh up to a ton and are often used year after year.





Racoon (Procyon lotor)

Our trail camera spotted a racoon walking on the ledge of the bulkhead above the floating wetlands.

Is that breakfast? Maybe this raccoon found something tasty at five o'clock in the morning. Raccoons are nocturnal omnivores, good climbers, and swimmers. They are intelligent and can solve complex problems. They prefer habitats near water. Like any wildlife, they can be unpredictable.
