

Early Voting Know Before You Go

The Prince George's Sports and Learning Complex is ONLY an Early Voting Site
Thursday October 24 – Thursday October 31

PLEASE NOTE Sunday October 27th – Voting will be facilitated in conjunction with a Washington Commanders Home Game – Start Time 4:25pm Game Day lots will open at 1pm please plan accordingly.

Voting will take place in the indoor track area (Field House) of the facility

All voters must enter through the rear doors adjacent to the two closest parking lots which will be Lots A and C Doors will open at 7am

Hours of Operation – 7am – 8pm

TIPS FOR ARRIVAL AND VOTING

Dress weather appropriate and expect lines.

Make sure your phone is adequately charged.

View your voting info well before you approach the entrance area and check-in line. Having your info in order and readily available will make it easier to get through the process.

GENERAL PARKING

General parking for voting will be in Lots A and C on a first come, first served basis. There will be onsite staff to direct voters accordingly. Once these lots fill the auxiliary Lot will be Northwest Field Red Zone Lot which will be accessed from the Prince George's Sports & Learning Complex property as overflow due to classes and programs.

ACCESSIBILITY PARKING

Accessibility parking spaces for voters will be available on a first come, first served basis in Lots A, C & H (Lot H is located at the front of the building). An appropriate state issued disabled placard or license plate is required. We recommend that guests requiring accessible parking plan to arrive at the lots as early, as spaces fill up quickly.

SHUTTLE SERVICE

Accessibility Shuttle service will be provided from Lot A, C, and H (as well as the Red Zone Lot if needed) and will be identified with designated shuttle pick up signage in these Lots.

NO SMOKING OR VAPING ALLOWED

The Prince Georges Sports & Learning Complex is a smoke-free facility. In compliance, smoking/vaping is not permitted anywhere within the facility. This policy applies to cigarettes, cigars, electronic cigarettes, marijuana pens or any other alternative smoking products. None are permitted. This includes the smoking of both legal and illegal substances.
