# Senior Nutrition Program & Transportation

The Prince George's County Senior Nutrition Program is back in operation at Laurel-Beltsville Senior Activity Center with meals being served on Monday-Friday: 11:30 am - 12:45 pm. Seniors 60 years and older are eligible for the Senior Nutrition Program. You must complete a registration form and make a reservation for your meal. Registration forms and a "Frequently Asked Questions" document are available at the Senior Center. Reservations must be made a week in advance and after a registration form has been submitted. The suggested donation is \$4.00. If you need to cancel your meal, please do so at least two days in advance with Rene, the Nutrition Manager at 301-206-3368.

Limited round-trip transportation services to LBSAC are available for registered lunch program participants. To schedule transportation, please contact the Department of Public Works & Transportation's intake line at 301-499-8603, option 6.

**Note:** There will be no lunch program when Prince George's County Public Schools have a two-hour delayed opening or are closed due to inclement weather conditions. Additional lunch days may be added as the need grows.

### **Requirements to participate in M-NCPPC Senior Activity Centers**

Eligibility requirements for participation at the Senior Activity Centers and senior classes/programs are:

- ◆ Minimum age of 60 or a Pre-Senior membership
- ◆ A M-NCPPC PARKS DIRECT Senior or Pre-Senior Identification Card
- ◆ Ability to participate in a recreation program setting that has 1-2 staff present (group size may vary from large to small daily)
- ◆ Ability to participate in recreational activities with minimal personal assistance
- ◆ Ability to take care of personal needs (i.e. personal hygiene, eating, mobility, medication, etc.)

## For Your Information

### Membership

LBSAC membership is required by all patrons. **M-NCPPC Senior ID** membership cards are available at no charge for Prince George's and Montgomery County residents age 60 and better. Pre-senior membership is available for a fee. Membership must be renewed every 12 months. Visit the Front desk for more information.

### Refund Policy

The registrant is entitled to a 100% credit to account or refund per request, in the event that M-NCPPC cancels a course. Registrant may withdraw from a course at any time prior to course end, and be entitled to receive a pro-rated credit to account, based on the number of classes remaining at the time the withdrawal is requested. All withdrawals performed within 7 days of the course start must be processed by the facility offering the program; withdrawals with additional advanced notice may be processed online. If registrant chooses to request a refund, a 20% Refund Administration Fee will be imposed, reducing the amount to be refunded. Trip refunds are only available if your registration is replaced by someone on the waiting list. No requests for refunds will be accepted after a course is completed. No cash refunds will be allowed. Refunds for credit card purchases will be issued as a credit to the PARKS DIRECT account, subject to the 20% Refund Administration Fee. Check refunds may take 3 - 4 weeks to process. No refund or credit will be issued for classes missed by the participant.
