Dear Adult Social Club Members and parents/caregivers,

We are thrilled to launch our Adult Social Club Programs for 2025! Our clubs aim to create opportunities for individuals with developmental disabilities to engage socially, forge friendships, explore new hobbies, and remain active within the community. Our clubs gather bi-monthly at different locations throughout the county, with activities led and monitored by our trained and experienced staff.

The membership fee for joining an Adult Social Club is \$70. Once you register, you will receive a monthly newsletter. Feel free to sign up for activities that meet your interest; please note that events may have an additional fee of \$5 and up, depending on the specific activity. All Social Club events are typically held on Fridays and Saturdays, while the Performing Arts Club gathers on Sundays.

Please note that Adult Social Club Registration Forms will only be accepted during the open enrollment window of January 2 - March 31, 2025. Registration forms received after that date will be referred to the 2026 Social Clubs. Spaces are limited per club, and they fill quickly. Registrations are processed on a first-come, first-served basis.

To register for 2025:

- 1) Complete your **2025 Registration Form** and return it to us, via mail or email within the open enrollment window.
- 2) Place a credit on your Parks Direct account for the registration fee of \$70. (Recommended)

- 3) You will be notified via email and mail when your Club Membership has been processed.
