a written account of a person's life




How Do You Write a Biography?

- Introduce yourself.
 - Include your first and last name, your grade and high school, and where you're from.
- Share academic and professional background.
 - Include favorite subject or academic strengths and achievements from school like honor class, honor roll, attendance awards, and jobs or past summer jobs.
- Highlight extracurricular activities.
 - This includes any sports, clubs, or organizations you're apart of both at and outside of school.
- Discuss your interests and hobbies.
 - Include things you like to do when you're not at school. Try not to repeat extracurricular activities.
- Share your future plans or goals.
 - Include colleges, careers, entrepreneurial goals, personal goals as well.

DO's

- Write in third person with a professional tone
- Show personality
- Tell a story
- Brag (this is not the time to be humble)
- Have a healthy balance of using pronouns vs.
 your name
- Use your last name to refer to yourself
- Quantify achievements (example: I helped 30 seniors cross the street)

DON'Ts

- Say "I"
- Overuse contractions like "don't," "can't,"
 "wouldn't"
- Share private information like where you live or where your parents work
- Speak casually
- Use slang or abbreviation
- Bring attention to things you're lacking
